- Formerly part of the Bathurst estate, the Round Tower dates back to the 1700's and has had a variety of uses, from a windmill to castellated folly and is now cleverly being converted into a 21st century home.
- The Round Tower stands amidst open countryside between the villages of Siddington and South Cerney both which offer day to day facilities.
